This Indenture made the 29th
of March Anno dñi one thousand six hundred
eighty five and in the xxv year of the Reigne

and Drucillis Christianson of the occupation of Bergen
in the County of Bergen and in the province aforesaid
Slaves of the other part **Witnesseth** that
the said lords proprietors as well for and in
consideration of the sum of one hundred seven pounds
sterling money in hand paid by the said Drucillis
Christianson to the Governor of the said province
to.
